1. Aims

Hosting a testimonial to Sabine Schmitz by featuring an event between German Manufacturer **only** Gr.A class cars at the Nurburgring Combined Circuit. The race will be an endurance event operating under the regular Flux Motorsport rules and regulations but operating a double race time (1.5hrs).

The event shall be run in 2 No. Semi-Final lobbies with a maximum of 32 Special Event seats being made available (with 16 potential reserves assigned). 8 drivers from each of the Semi-Final lobbies shall then progress to a 16 driver grid Grand Final event, raced under the same track and weather conditions with a grand champion being crowned with whomever wins the race.

All races in the event are subject to Flux Motorsports general Rules & Regulations, Code of Conduct, Race Licence and Driver Penalty systems. For More information see:

All events shall be streamed (with commentary) via the Flux Motorsport TV YouTube channel.

2. Semi-Final Process

32 Driver seats will be made available by means of 2 No. separate Semi-Final lobbies ran at 45minutes under dry weather conditions on the current date settings set for the date of the qualification events.

Both semi-final events shall take place simultaneously on the: **18th April 2021** at 1500hrs (UK).

Both semi-final events shall be hosted in 'Broadcast Mode' to allow a 16 driver grid, and shall be broadcast simultaneously to the Flux Motorsport YouTube Channel.

Events will be 20 minutes of qualification to decide the starting grid.

The Top 8 No. drivers shall be progressed to the final event (following any time penalties applied following Stewards Inquiries).

There shall be no limitations to pit-stops.

A practice lobby shall be created 30 minutes before the start time of the event. Any driver/s not present in the lobby with 15 minutes remaining of the session shall be subject to replacement with a Reserve Driver. A Reserve Driver 'callout' on Discord shall be made to the Special Event Discord channel on a first come first served basis.

If the listed 'driver' appears in the lobby before the Reserve Accepts any invitation, their seat shall remain.

Drivers must have selected their cars prior to the race by adding it into the 'Car Selection' Discord channel.

3. Grand Final Process

The Grand Final shall consist of the top 8 drivers from each of the 2 No. Semi-Final to make a total 16 driver grid. Drivers are **not** permitted to change their car selection from their Semi-Final selection.

Both semi-final events shall take place simultaneously on the: **25th April** at 1500hrs (UK).

Both semi-final events shall be hosted in 'Broadcast Mode' to allow a 16 driver grid, and shall be broadcast simultaneously to the Flux Motorsport YouTube Channel.

Events will be 20 minutes of qualification to decide the starting grid.

The Top 8 No. drivers shall be progressed to the final event (following any time penalties applied following Stewards Inquiries).

There shall be no limitations to pit-stops.

Prior to the Grand Final, a communication and change shall be made within the Discord which;

- a) Removes Reserve Driver Tags
- b) Changes drivers which have not qualified for the Grand-Final into the Reserve Driver role.
- c) Message posted to state that un-qualified drivers shall be eligible as reserves for the Grand-Final in their order of race position (i.e, 9th Place in either of the Semi-Finals shall get first option if a Reserve Spot opens up)

A practice lobby shall be created 30 minutes before the start time of the event. Any driver/s not present in the lobby with 15 minutes remaining of the session shall be subject to replacement with a Reserve Driver with a callout being made in the Discord Channel.

The Reserve Drivers shall be selected by finishing order in the Semi-Final (i.e, 9th Place finishers shall receive first priority on a first come first serve basis, then 10th Place e.t.c until the place/s is filled)

If the listed 'driver' appears in the lobby before the Reserve Accepts any invitation, their seat shall remain.

The winner of the event shall be the first person crossing the line following any time penalties added from any potential stewards inquiries.

4. Stewards Inquiries Process

Due to the shortened nature of the events, stewards inquiries should be submitted no later than 24hours after the corresponding events **start** time. Time Penalties and subsequent Race Licence penalties shall operate as per regular Flux Motorsport rules.
